Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis dan fungsi-fungsi tindak ilokusi dalam Film Marnie's World. Penulis menggunakan teori jenis-jenis tindak ilokusi oleh Austin dan teori fungsi-fungsi tindak ilokusi oleh Leech. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif. Dalam proses pengumpulan data penulis menggunakan beberapa langkah yaitu pertama Penulis menonton film *Marnie's World* secara kontiniti. Kedua menulis semua ucapan yang terdapat dalam film *Marnie's World*, kemudian mengklasifikasikan ucapanucapan tersebut menurut jenis dan fungsi sesuai dengan teori yang digunakan.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukan bahwa ada 25 ucapan yang ditemukan dalam film *Marnie's World* yang mengandung tindak ilokusi. Dari 25 ucapan tersebut, terdapat 5 jenis tindak ilokusi yaitu verdictive, exercitive, commisive, behabitive, dan expositive. Sedangkan terdapat 4 fungsi tindak ilokusi dalam film *Marnie's World* yaitu competitive, convivial, collaborative, dan conflictive.

The purpose of this study was to find out the types and the functions of illocutionary acts in *Marnie's World* movie. The writer used types of illocutionary acts theory proposed by Austin and theory functions of illocutionary acts by Leech. This study used descriptive qualitative method. In process of collecting data, the writer used several steps, as follows; firstly, watched *Marnie's World* movie with continuously. Secondly, wrote all utterances from Marnies *World* movie, then classified the utterance into types and functions of illocutionary acts. The results of this study show that there are 25 utterances in which contain of illocutionary acts. From the 25 utterance, there are 5 types of illocutionary acts as follows; verdictive, exercitive, commisive, behabitive, and expositive. Meanwhile, there are 4 functions of illocutionary acts found in *Marnie's World* movie, they are competitive, convivial, collaborative, and conflictive.
