#### **ABSTRAK**

Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk menemukan tipe – tipe kecemasan yang dialami oleh karakter utama dan untuk menemukan strategi mengatasi kecemasan yang dialami tokoh utama dalam novel. Desain penelitian adalah metode penelitian kualitatif. Penelitian ini menggunakan teori kecemasaan Barlow dan Durand dan teori Studi Bandingan dari Greenberger dan Padesky. Data tersebut diambil dari *novel The SumOF All Fears* dalam bentuk frasa dan kutipan.

Hasil penelitian menunjukan bahwa ada empat tipe kecemasan yang dialami Jack Ryan dalam *novel The Sum of All Fears*. Berdasarkan teori tipe tipe kecemasan yang dikemukakan oleh Barlow dan Durand penulis hanya temukan empat tipe kecemasaan yang dialami Jack, yakni, : Phobias, Social Anxiety, Panic Disorder, Health Worries. Sementara itu, terdapat empat strategi untuk mengatasi kecemasaan menurut teori dari Greenberger dan Padesky diantaranya adalah mindfulness and acceptance, breathing, progressive muscle relaxation, and imagery.

#### **ABSTRACT**

The purpose of this study is to find the types of anxiety experienced by the main character and to find strategies to overcome anxiety experienced by the main character in the novel. The research design is a qualitative research method. This research uses Barlow and Durand's anxiety theory and Greenberger's and Padesky's Comparative Study theory. The data is taken from the *novel The Sum of All Fears* in the form of phrases and quotes.

The results of the study show that there are four types of anxiety experienced by Jack Ryan in The Sum of All Fears. Based on the theory of the types of anxiety put forward by Barlow and Durand, the authors only found four types of anxiety experienced by Jack, namely: Phobias, Social Anxiety, Panic Disorder, Health Worries. Meanwhile, according to Greenberger and Padesky's theory, there are four strategies to deal with anxiety, including mindfulness and acceptance, breathing, progressive muscle relaxation, and imagery.
