ABSTRAK

Tujuan dari penelitian ini yaitu untuk menemukan tipe-tipe pola kalimat dan tipe-tipe dominan pola kalimat pada lirik lagu Calum Scott.

Untuk menjawab permasalahan tersebut di atas, peneliti menggunakan metode kualitatif sebagai lingkup penelitian. Peneliti menggunakan teori dari Burton dan Roberts tentang sentence pattern untuk menggambarkan atau menganalisis pola kalimat yang ada dalam setiap lirik lagu yang sudah dipilih.

Berdasarkan hasil penelitian ini, penulis mengidentifikasi enam jenis pola kalimat pada dua lirik lagu. Lirik lagu pertama (No Matter What) terdiri dari tujuh belas data pada pola I (S + VT + DO), Pola II (S + Intr.V) ada dua data, Pola III (S + Distr.V + DO + IO) tidak ada data, Pola IV (S + Int.V + SP) ada delapan data, Pola (S + Com.V + DO + OP) ada tiga data, Pola VI (S + Prep.V + PC) ada enam data. Penulis juga mengidentifikasi empat tipe kalimat dengan total datanya sebanyak tiga puluh delapan kalimat dari dua lirik lagu dengan menggunakan teori dari Joshi Manik tentang type of sentence. Dua lirik lagu terdiri dari sembilan belas data simple simple sentence, compound sentence sebanyak dua belas data, complex sentence sebanyak empat data, dan compound complex sentence sebanyak tiga data.

ABSTRCT

The aim of this study was to find the types of sentence pattern and the most dominant of sentence pattern used in Calum Scott's song lyrics.

In order to answer the problems of the study above, writer used qualitative methods as the scope of the study. The writer used the theory from Burton and Roberts about sentence pattern to describe or analyze the sentence patterns that exist in each of the selected song lyrics.

Based on the results of this study, the study identifies six types of sentence pattern on two songs lyrics. The first song lyrics (No Matter What) consists of seventeen data in pattern I (S + VT + DO), Pattern II (S + Intr.V) has two data, Pattern III (S + Distr.V + DO + IO) has no data, Pattern IV (S + Int.V + SP) has eight data, Pattern (S + Com.V + DO + OP) has three data, Pattern VI (S + Prep.V + PC) has 6 data. The study also identifies four types with total of its data about thirty eight of sentence from two song lyrics by using the theory of Joshi Manik about type of sentence. The two songs lyrics consist of nineteen data of simple sentence, compound sentence has twelve data, complex sentence has four data, and compound complex sentence has three data.
