ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui keberanian dalam diri Atticus sebagai karakter utama dalam novel *To Kill A Mockingbird* karya Harper Lee. Desain penelitian pada analisis ini adalah metode penelitian kualitatif. Penelitian ini menggunakan teori keberanian Daniel Putman untuk menganalisis bentuk-bentuk keberanian dan faktor yang mempengaruhi karakter dalam moral keberanian. Data tersebut berupa ucapan dan tindakan. Dalam penelitian ini data diambil dari kutipan berupa dialog, kalimat, frasa dan kata.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa karakter utama Atticus memiliki jiwa keberanian dari tiga bentuk keberanian yang ada. Ketiga bentuk keberanian yang ditemukan merupakan sebuah hal yang mendarah daging dalam diri manusia yang menjadikan manusia tersebut berguna tidak hanya untuk dirinya sendiri melainkan berguna dalam masyarakat dan lingkungannya. Inilah yang merupakan tahap pertama dalam cara kerja bentuk-bentuk keberanian dalam diri karakter, yaitu keberanian fisik, keberanian moral dan keberanian vital. Ketiga bentuk dari keberanian karakter ini, memunculkan beberapa faktor yang mempengaruhi keberanian moral karakter, yaitu faktor sosial dan politik, situasional, personal, dan persepsi terhadap situasi.

ABSTRACT

This study aimed to determine the courage of Atticus as the main character in the novel *To Kill A Mockingbird* by Harper Lee. The research design in this analysis was a qualitative research method. This study used Daniel Putman's theory of courage to analyze the forms of courage and the factors that influenced character in moral courage. The data were in the form of speech and actions. In this study data were taken from quotes in the form of dialogues, sentences, phrases and words.

The results of this study show that the main character Atticus has a spirit of courage from the three forms of courage that exist. The three forms of courage found are ingrained in humans that make these humans useful not only for themselves but useful in society and their environment. This is the first stage in how the forms of courage work in character, namely physical courage, moral courage and vital courage. These three forms of character courage give rise to several factors that affect the moral courage of the character, namely social and political, situational, personal, and perception of the situation.
