Penelitian ini merupakan analisis kata-kata sumpah serapah yang digunakan dalam Film Avatar. Tujuan dari penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis kata sumpah serapah dan mendeskripsikan fungsi kata-kata sumpah srapahyang terdapat dalam Film Avatar. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif. Sumber data diambil dari Film Avatar. Penulis mengadopsi teori Anderson dan Trudgill dan Pinker untuk mengetahui fungsi dan jenis kata sumpah serapah yang terdapat dalam Film Avatar. Pengumpulan data dalam penelitian ini menggunakan metode studi audio visual dan dokumentasi.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan empat jenis kata makian dan fungsinya dari 69 data, yaitu: 1). umpatan, umpatan kasar, jenaka, 4) kata bantu, 5) kata makian yang berkaitan dengan tabu atau agama atau sumpah. Sedangkan fungsi kata umpatan diantaranya adalah umpatan kasar, katarsis, disfemistik, idiomatik, dan disfemistik.

ABSTRACT

This study was an analysis of swear words used *Avatar* Movie. The aims of this research were to find out types of swear words and to describe the functions of swear words found in Avatar Movie. This study used descriptive qualitative method. The source of data was taken from *Avatar* Movie. The writer adopted the theories of Anderson and Trudgill and Pinker to find out functions and types of swear words found in Avatar Movie. The data in this study used an audio-visual and and documentation study method.

The result of this study shows four types of swear words and functions from 69 data, there are: 1). expletive swearing, abusive swearing, humorous, 4) auxiliary, 5) swear words related to taboo or religion or oath. While the functions of swear words belong to abusive, cathartic, dysphemistic, idiomatic, and dysphemistic swearing.
