Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui jenis-jenis makna bahasa dan jenis-jenis nilai khususnya nilai budaya dalam cerita rakyat Lio. Objek penelitian ini adalah lima cerita rakyat Lio yang berjudul: *Tiwu Lopi*, *Tiwu Sora*, *Tiwu Mbata*, *Ro'a No'o Te'u*, dan *Bobi No'o Nombi* yang terdapat di dalam buku "Cerita Rakyat Lio Flores". Data yang digunakan dalam penelitian ini berupa kata, frasa, klausa, dan kalimat yang terdapat dalam cerita rakyat tersebut. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif untuk menyajikan temuan-temuan yang ditemukan selama penelitian secara menyeluruh dan komprehensif.

Temuan dari penelitian ini mengungkapkan jenis-jenis makna bahasa dan jenis-jenis nilai budaya yang mencerminkan identitas orang Lio. Di antara tujuh jenis makna bahasa yang dikemukakan oleh Leech, hanya empat jenis yang ditemukan, yaitu makna konseptual, makna konotatif, makna sosial, dan makna afektif. Kemudian, ada lima jenis nilai budaya yang ditemukan dengan menggunakan teori Scheler, yaitu nilai hedonis, nilai material, nilai sosioentris, nilai etis, dan nilai religius.

ABSTRACT

The aims of this study were to know the types of language meaning and the kinds of value specifically cultural value in the Lionese folktale. The objects of this study were the five Lionese folktales entitled: *Tiwu Lopi, Tiwu Sora, Tiwu Mbata, Ro'a No'o Te'u* and *Bobi No'o Nombi* contained in the book "*Cerita Rakyat Lio Flores*". The data adopted in this study were in the form of words, phrases, clauses, and sentences that written in the story. This study employed qualitative descriptive methods to thoroughly and comprehensively present the findings uncovered during the study.

The findings of this study reveal the types of language meaning and the kinds of cultural values that reflect Lionese identity. Among the seven types of language meaning proposed by Leech, only four types are found, namely conceptual meaning, connotative meaning, social meaning, and affective meaning. Then, there are five kinds of cultural value found by using Scheler's theory, namely hedonistic value, material value, socioentric value, ethical value and religious value.
