ABSTRAK

Pidato adalah bentuk komunikasi lisan yang mana biasanya disampaikan pada kegiatan formal. Penelitian ini menganalisis tentang tujuh standar textuality dalam teks pidato. Standar textuality adalah kriteria yang digunakan untuk menentukan apakah sebuah teks koherensi dan efektif dalam menyampaikan pesan. Tujuh standar textuality diperkenalkan oleh De Beaugrande dan Dressler yang meliputi kohesi, koherensi, tujuan, penerimaan, informatif, situationalitas, dan intertextualitas. Tujuan penelitian ini adalah untuk mengetahui tujuh standar textuality yang terdapat di dalam text pidato pada kompetisi pidato Bahasa Inggris FL2SN tahun 2024 di Kabupaten Ngada. Penelitian ini menggunakan pendekatan deskriptif kualitatif dengan metode observasi.

Hasil penelitian menunjukkan tujuh standar tekstualitas yang ditemukan dalam video yang dipilih. Tipe standar yang paling banyak ditemukan adalah tipekohesi yaitu sebanyak 26 data. Sedangkan tipe standar tekstualiti yang lainnya hanya terdiri dari beberapa data yang mana tidak sebanyak data dari tipe standar kohesi. Hal ini membuktikan bahwa dalam suatu teks formal seperti teks pidato terdapat standar tekstualiti. Standar tekstualiti sangat penting dalam penyusunan suatu teks agar menjadi suatu teks yang informatif, bermakna, teratur, dan mudah dipahami oleh segala kalangan.

ABSTRACT

Speech is a form of oral communication which is usually delivered at formal activities. This study analyzes seven standards of textuality in speech texts. Textuality standards are criteria used to determine whether a text is coherent and effective in conveying a message. 7 standards of textuality were introduced by De Beaugrande and Dressler which include cohesion, coherence, purpose, acceptability, informativeness, situationality, and intertextuality. The aim of this study is to determine the seven textuality standards contained in the speech text at the 2024 FL2SN English speech competition in *Ngada* regency. This study uses a qualitative descriptive approach with observation methods.

The study results showed that seven textual standards were found in the selected videos. The standard type that is most often found is the cohesion type, namely 26 data. Meanwhile, other types of textuality standards only consist of some data, which is not as much data as the cohesion standard type. This proves that in a formal text such as a speech text, there are very important textual standards in preparing a text so that it becomes a text that is informative, meaningful, orderly, and easy to understand by all groups.





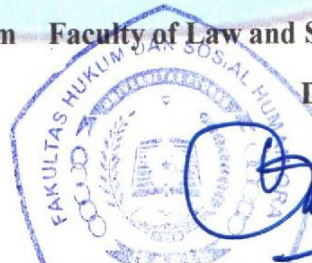
