ABSTRAK

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui bentuk-bentuk jargon dan makna jargon yang digunakan oleh para anggota pemain game free fire di komunitas Sparta. Desain penelitian pada analisis ini adalah metode penelitian deskriptif kualitatif. Penelitian ini menggunakan teori Halligan dan teori Leech untuk menganalisis bentuk dan makna jargon. Data tersebut berupa ujaran. Dalam penelitian ini, data diambil dari ujaran-ujaran yang mengandung jargon ketika pemain free fire berbicara satu sama lain dan rekaman wawancara.

Hasil penelitian ini menunjukkan bahwa terdapat 47 jargon yang digunakan oleh pemain free fire di komunitas Sparta yang terdiri dari kata, frasa, akronim dan singkatan. Bentuk jargon yang paling banyak ditemukan adalah bentuk kata dengan 23 data, frasa 9 data, akronim 6 data, dan singkatan 8 data. Terdapat enam makna yang ditemukan oleh peneliti, yaitu makna konseptual (denotatif), makna konotatif, makna sosial, makna afektif, makna kolokatif, dan makna tematik.

ABSTRACT

This study aimed to determine the forms of jargon and the meaning of jargon used by *free fire* players in the Sparta community. The study in this analysis used a qualitative method. This study used Halligan's theory and Leech's theory to analyze the form and meaning of jargon. The data was in the form of utterances. In this study, the data was taken from utterances containing jargon when *free fire* players talked to each other and interview recordings.

The result of this study shows that there are 47 jargons used by *free fire* players in the Sparta community consisting of words, phrases, acronyms, and abbreviations. The most common form of jargon found is the word form with 23 data, phrases 9 data, acronyms 6 data, and abbreviation 8 data. There are six meaning found by researcher, namely conceptual (denotative) meaning, connotative meaning, social meaning, affective meaning, collocative meaning, and thematic meaning.




