

Penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui ambisi yang tergambar didalam puisi Elizabeth Browning. Penelitian ini menggunakan metode deskriptif kualitatif. Data diambil dari dua puisi Elizabeth Browning, dalam bentuk garis, kata-kata frasa dan bait. Pendekatan yang digunakan penulis adalah pendekatan feminism karena penelitian ini berkaitan dengan persamaan gender antara laki-laki dan perempuan. Penelitian ini menggunakan dua sumber data yaitu sumber data primer dan sumber data sekunder. Sumber data primer dalam penelitian ini adalah dua puisi Elizabeth Browning itu sendiri yaitu *How Do I love Thee* dan *The Lady's Yes*. Sumber data sekunder adalah buku, jurnal dan biografi dari Elizabeth Browning.

## ABSTRACT

This study aims at determining the ambitions depicted in Elizabeth Browning's poem. This study used descriptive qualitative method. The data are taken from two of Elizabeth Browning's poems, in the form of lines, words, phrases and stanzas. The approach used by the writer is a feminist approach because this research deals with gender equality between men and women. This study uses two data sources, that are primary and secondary data sources. The primary data sources in this study were two of Elizabeth Browning's poems, namely *How Do I love Thee* and *The Lady's Yes*. Secondary data sources are books, journals and biographies of Elizabeth Browning.

The results of this study show that there is a woman's ambition which is reflected in the two Elizabeth Browning poems by collecting indications of ambition from the expressions in Elizabeth Browning's poem text. In the first poem *How I Love Thee* shows the ambition of women in loving their partners wholeheartedly, breaking the matchmaking rules that prevailed during the Victorian era and in the second poem *The Lady's Yes* shows the ambition of women who struggle to regain women's rights, and the firmness of women in responding attitude of men at that time.




